

Blessed Trinity Shrine Retreat Guest Guidelines, COVID-19

During this difficult time with COVID-19, we respectfully request that guests follow the established guidelines to protect yourself and others, and to help us provide the best guest experience possible.

- Guests who have knowingly been exposed to, or lived with, someone who has had
 COVID-19 during the 14 days prior to a retreat, should not attend.
- If the guest has serious underlying medical conditions, or are at high risk for severe illness from COVID-19, we recommend you stay at home. Please consult your healthcare provider to determine whether you have medical conditions that place you at high risk.
- Guests who contract COVID-19 within 14 days of their retreat, should notify BTSR. BTSR will inform all retreatants, staff, sisters, and volunteers who were on retreat with the guest.
- If any employee contracts COVID-19, BTSR will inform all retreatants who were on retreat within 14 days prior to the positive test.

During your stay:

- Upon arrival, all guests will:
 - o Be asked to wear a face mask. Please bring your own mask.
 - o Receive a temperature check with a wand.
 - Fill out the guest health screening form.
 - Be asked to sanitize their hands.
- Temperatures will be checked daily for all guests, staff, sisters, and volunteers.
- Guests, volunteers, staff, and sisters with a temperature above 100° F will be asked to leave. BTSR will refund unused portions of the retreat fee. Please see our cancellation policy.
- All guests, staff, sisters, and volunteers must wear a mask or face covering at all times while inside the buildings.
- We ask that each guest cooperate with the new meal procedures.
 - Guests will place their number at their chosen seat. This will remain their seat during the duration of their stay.
 - Guests will walk through the buffet line one at a time.
 - Guests must be wearing a mask.
 - Guests will be served their chosen food by kitchen staff or a volunteer.
 - Upon finishing a meal, guests will leave their dishes at their table.
 - No more than two guests will sit at each dining room table to maintain a 6-foot distance.
 - We suggest you consider bringing your own reusable beverage container.

- At check-in, guests will receive laminated numbers for placement at your preferred dining room seat and chapel seat. This will remain your seat for the duration of your retreat.
- All guests will have their own bathroom unless there is a family unit wishing to share.
- All overnight guests are asked to use their private restroom rather than the public restroom.
- A plastic bag will be provided in each guest suite you. We ask that you place all of your linens in the bag prior to your departure.

Hermitage Guests – in main building

- If you wish to enter the main building for liturgy or prayers, prior to entering the main building, you will:
 - Receive a temperature check with a wand.
 - Be asked to apply a face mask.
 - Be asked to sanitize your hands.
 - Receive a laminated number you can use to choose your seat in the chapel. This seat will remain yours for the duration of your stay.

Our cancellation policy

- Should you need to cancel your reservation, BTSR will issue a credit, valid for 12 months, for a future retreat.
- If you need to leave a retreat due to symptoms of illness, BTSR will refund the unused portion of your stay.
- BTSR reserves the right to change the cancellation policy at any time.
